ESIAS BOSCH

Born in 1926 in Winburg, O.F.S. Studied in Johannesburg and at the Central School of Art, London. Has exhibited in many European countries and the U.S.A. Lives in the Eastern Transvaal.

Won the silver medal award of 1963 at the Washington 9th International Exhibition of Ceramic Art held at the Kiln Club International. Thirty-nine countries took part in this exhibition and there were more than 500 entries.

Esias Bosch has concentrated on the production of stoneware. The purity of his shapes and the perfection of his glaze and aesthetic metifs derived from birds and plants, make him a potter of unusual ability and rare sensitivity of form.

Esias Bosch has just completed a large mural for the new Schlesinger Centre in Braamfontein, Johannesburg.
