If you think about Africans being restricted in the Union have a look at this exhibition. If you think there was no native art in South Africa look at this show and find a continuity of tradition in form from the half-known beauties of past craftsmen. Sculpture is full of new ideas, painting is alive and truly African, and drawing is strong and represents three-dimensional form. The work is not Europeanised, but expresses the African experience. One of the artists has written a poem in pencil on a massive figure drawing. Go and read it as an expression of life. All these artists express a resurgence of Africa, and it is important that all have been shown in South African art galleries. A fascinating show. Here is a list of names: Dumile Feni, Leonard Matsoso, Louis Maqhubela, Stanley Mkhosi, Lucky Sibila and Lucas Sithole. They are a credit to their homeland.
