About the Artist

Ulrich Schwanecke was born in Germany in 1932 and emigrated to South Africa at the age of twenty. He is a water-colourist best known for his renderings of rugged and arid landscapes many of which consist of three or more panels.

Ulrich obtained a BA Fine Art Degree through UNISA in 1969 and is a Fellow and Life Member of the Watercolour Society of South Africa, a society which owes much to his continued support and involvement.
