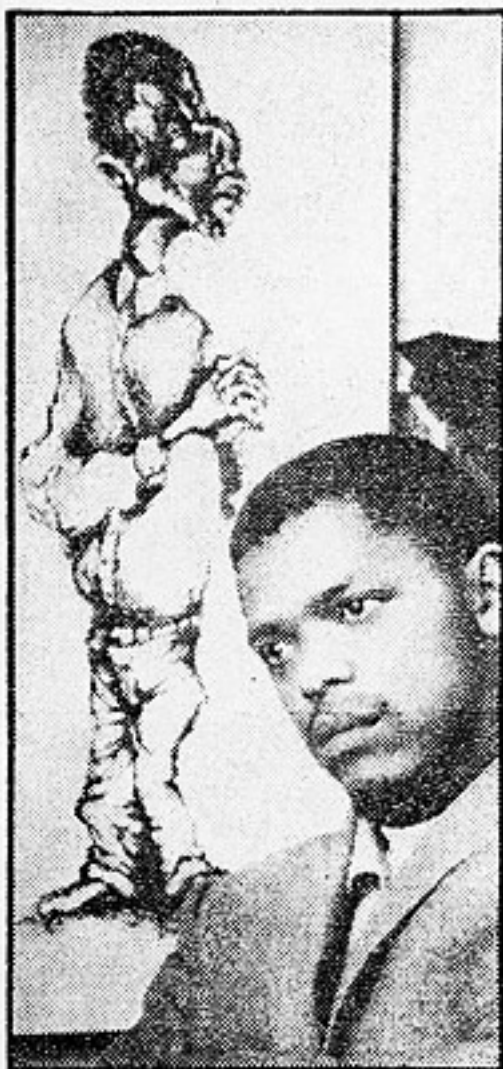


AFRICAN TO SHOW HIS DRAWINGS



AN EXHIBITION of charcoal drawings by Dumile, the well known African artist and sculptor from Johannesburg, opens at the Durban City Hall Art Gallery today. This is the first time that the 23-year-old artist has exhibited in Durban.

Keen on drawing since his childhood when he used to sketch on scraps of paper and walls, he was "discovered" a few years ago by Mrs. F. Haenggi, director of the Gallery 101 in Johannesburg.
